Award Information

- The NIH, via support from the FDA Center for Tobacco Products (CTP), intends to fund approximately 20 applications, totaling up to \$20 million for fiscal year 2014.
- Applicants may request up to \$1,000,000 **total costs** per year
- Applicants may request a project period up to 2 years., not to exceed the remaining number of years in the current project period.
- Only one application per P30 award can be submitted in response to this RFA.



Award Information

- Applications must be received on or before March 26, 2013
- Earliest possible start date will be December 1, 2013
- Awards will cycle with the Parent P30 award
- Awards will include a term of award requiring a separate interim progress report at six months
- Annual progress reports will be required as a separately labeled section of the parent progress report
