Award Information

- * The NIH, via support from the FDA Center for Tobacco Products (CTP), intends to fund up to 10 applications, totaling up to \$3 million for fiscal year 2016
- * Applicants may request up to \$300,000 **direct costs**, per budget year
- * Applicants may request a project period of up to 3 years
- * Foreign institutions and non-domestic components of US organizations **are** eligible to apply. Foreign components **are** allowable

Award Information

- * Letters of Intent are due **on October 13, 2015**
- * Earliest possible start date will be **July 2016**
- * Awards will include a special term, requiring a **separate interim progress** report at the six month portion of each budget year
- * Reminders:
 - * FDA-funded awards **do not** have carryover authority; therefore, a prior approval request must be submitted for situations where there is a bona fide need
