

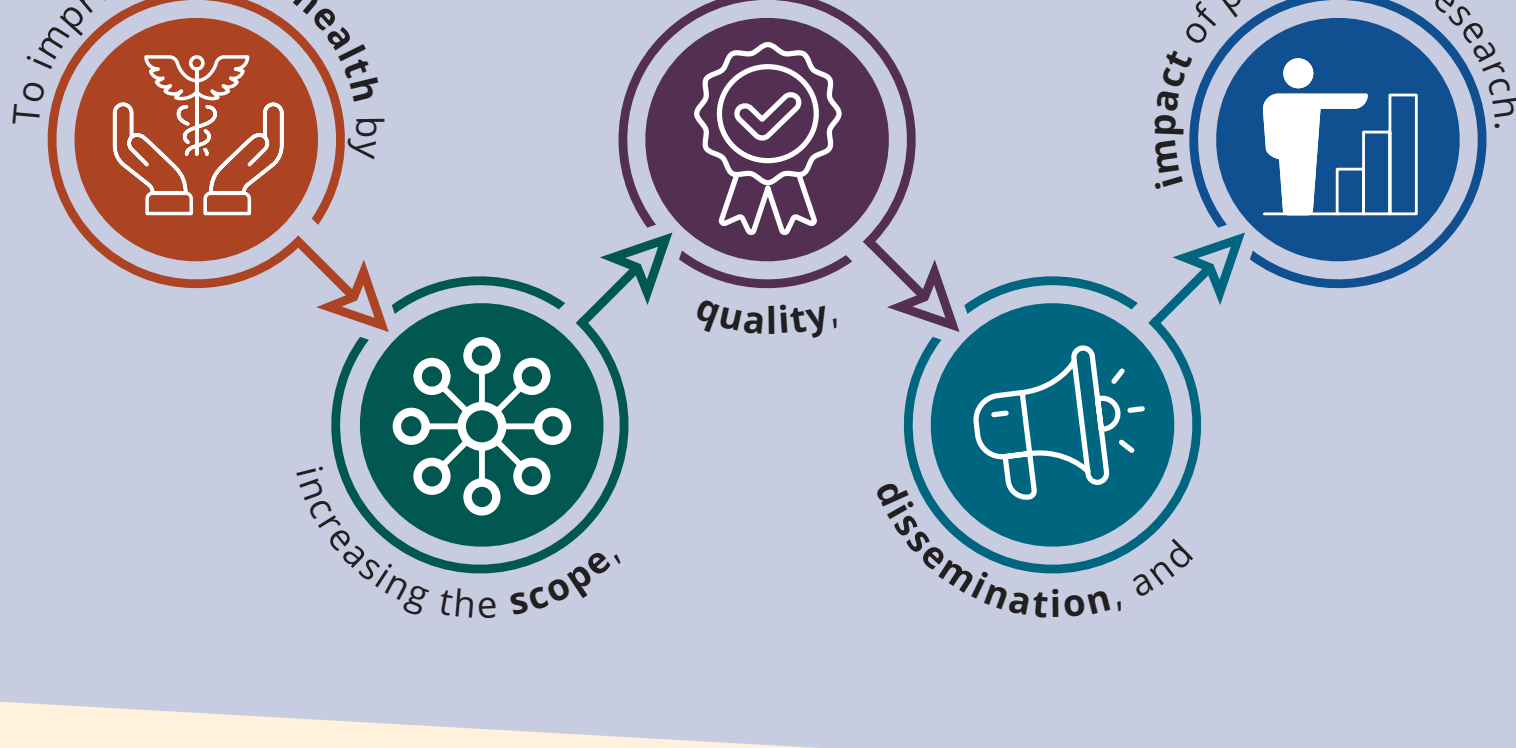

Milestones

- 1986** Founded
- 1991** Helped launch the Women's Health Initiative
- 1993** Set up the Office of Rare Diseases Research
- 1995** Added the Office of Dietary Supplements
- 2002** Developed the Medicine in the Media course
- 2007** Started the Mind the Gap seminar series
- 2013** Established the Tobacco Regulatory Science Program
- 2021** Introduced the ADVANCE: Advancing Prevention Research for Health Equity research effort

Innovative Portfolio Analysis

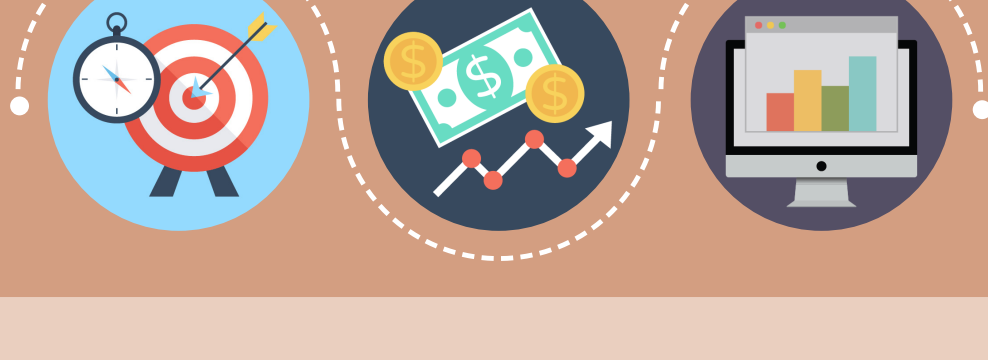
ODP's analysis of **14,523 abstracts** shows that in **fiscal year 2019**, prevention research represented:

- **20.7%** of all new NIH research projects, and
- **27.4%** of all new NIH research funding.



Prevention Initiatives

Since 2012, the ODP issued **40+** trans-NIH funding opportunities and provided **\$17.6+ M** in co-funding support, for **303+** prevention research projects.

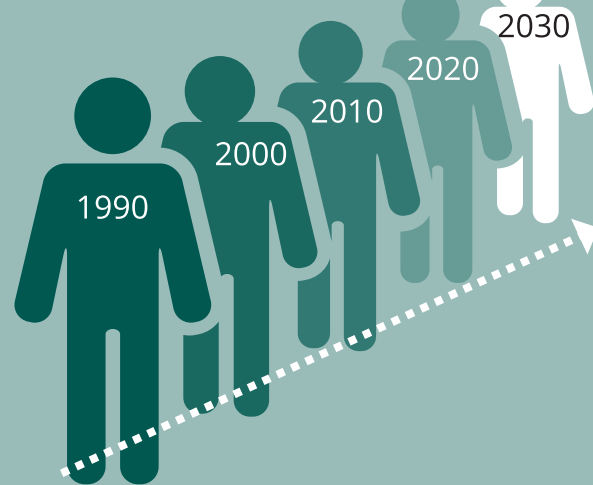


Collaborations

- Brought together **59 members** of the Prevention Research Coordinating Committee.
- Organized **7 Scientific Interest Groups** to address unmet prevention needs.

Coordinated support for **23 Tobacco Centers of Regulatory Science** and **320+** tobacco regulatory research projects through the Tobacco Regulatory Science Program, a strong partnership between FDA and NIH.

- Partnered with the Community Preventive Services Task Force (CPSTF) for **25 years**. NIH-funded research has informed **60+** CPSTF findings.
- Monitored NIH research activities to address **50+** and help upgrade **11 U.S. Preventive Services Task Force "insufficient evidence" statements**.



Represented the NIH in **5 decades** of the federal Healthy People initiative.

Programs

- Organized Medicine in the Media, helping **500+** journalists evaluate research.
- Sponsored the NIH Consensus Development Program for **26 years**, resulting in **160+** statements.

Hosted **66 Mind the Gap webinars** - viewed **27,000+** times.

Hosted **10 Pathways to Prevention (P2P) workshops**.

Highlighted **8 future leaders** in prevention through the Early-Stage Investigator Lecture.

Selected **26 researchers** to give the Robert S. Gordon, Jr. Lecture in Epidemiology.

Resources

Created a directory of **4,086 Methods Experts** via the Prevention Research Expertise Survey.

Compiled and managed **3 Libraries** of federal prevention research resources, funding opportunities, and trainings.

Offered a free, 7-part course on group-randomized trials (GRTs). **3,368 Views**

Developed a resource site with a sample-size calculator for GRTs. **2,995 Completions**
