Tobacco Regulatory Science Program (TRSP)

- TRSP coordinates the inter-agency partnership between FDA's Center for Tobacco Products (CTP) and the NIH
- TRSP has NIH oversight responsibility for the trans-NIH grant activities supported by CTP funding (e.g., RFAs, grantee mtgs)
- TRSP funding represents an addition to the NIH tobacco research program and does not replace or diminish existing tobacco research activities at NIH Institutes or Centers (ICs).
